A significant chunk of the additional processing supply increase is Chipstock in Ontario. Alberta has an additional 2 million cwt. of processing potatoes, similar to the April holdings. NB Holdings are now revised to 4.3% below May of 2017. Large imports have allowed PEI Holdings to remain fairly consistent for their needs. Quebec's increase is also needed. Manitoba holdings are coming down nicely.
