Fresh Holdings are 2.0% or 259,000 hundred weight above the 3-yr. average, with 13.3 million hundred weight in storages on January 1st. New Brunswick has the largest decline in fresh holdings compared to their 3-yr. average at -13.9%. Ontario, Quebec, and Prince Edward Island are the provinces with respective increases of 8.5%, 5.3%, and 4.8%.
