Total Canadian Potato Storage Holdings on January 1 are very close to the 3-yr. average at 69.6 million hundred weight. Manitoba, New Brunswick, and British Columbia report decreases of stocks on hand from one year ago. Provinces with more potatoes in storage than one year ago, and also above their 3-yr. average include, Alberta, Ontario, Quebec, and Prince Edward Island. Decreases in holdings in NB and BC are driven by movement, whereas the decrease in Manitoba is the result of decreased supply.
