Seed Inventory on March 1, 2020 is -1.6% or 146,000 hundred weight below the 3-yr. average. Last month's seed stocks in Alberta were 20.8% above their 3-yr. average but with rapid movement and early planting in the U.S., are only 0.8% above their 3-yr. average on March 1. Potatoes expected to be utilized as seed in PEI are 10.8% above their 3-yr. average.
