Fresh Holdings in Canada have been lowered substantially over the past month with 10 million cwt. left to go to market. Stocks on February 1, 2021 are 5.1% below the 3-yr. average. PEI leads the decrease with 26% less than average followed by NB with a decline of 21%. Table stocks in Western Canada are up 27.5%, led by Manitoba with an increase of 33%. Higher cullage rates may not be entirely counted for in those figures. In the central region of the country, Ontario fresh stocks are up 17.3% above 3-yr. averages.
