Seed Inventory on March 1, 2021 is 4% below 3-yr. average levels at 8,360,000 cwt. All four Eastern provinces have a reduction in seed available for planting, led by New Brunswick which is down 37.7%. British Columbia seed stocks are 25% below averages. Alberta and Manitoba seed holdings are up 12.4% and 10% above average, respectively.
