Fresh Holdings in Canada on June 1, 2021 are 3.6% below the 3-yr. average with 2.2 million hundred weight left in storage. Supply of table potatoes is tight in the Atlantic region with an average reduction of 42% in PEI (54% of 2020). In the west, a slower marketing year for red potatoes has created more inventory for this time of year in Manitoba and British Columbia.
