Seed Inventory on December 1, 2021 is 10.1 million hundred weight which is 2% above 3-yr. average levels. PEI, which represents 33% of the acres certified for seed in Canada is down 24%. Alberta which certifies 22% of the seed acres in Canada, has the largest seed stocks on hand at 3.6 million hundred weight, which is 6% above 3yr. averages. New Brunswick and Quebec stocks of potatoes intended to be used as seed, are each up 15% above 3-yr. averages.
