Total Canadian Potato Storage Holdings on January 1, 2022 are at almost 80 million hundred weight, which is 20% above 3-yr. average levels of 66.5 million hundred weight. Eastern Canada is the biggest contributor as a result of the large crop dug in the 4 Eastern Provinces. Also compounding the stocks increase is an Embargo on PEI Potatoes preventing them from being shipped to the United States since November 22<sup>nd</sup>. The Canadian market has not been able to handle the additional volume domestically.
