Fresh Holdings in Canada on March 1 are estimated at 11.8 million hundred weight. Eastern Canada stocks are 52% above 3yr. averages, led by New Brunswick at 87%. PEI has had to destroy a significant portion of their fresh potatoes intended for the US market and reflects lower levels compared to last month. Fresh stocks are down in both British Columbia and Manitoba.
