Seed Inventory on April 1, 2022 is 2% below historical 3-yr. averages at 7.3 million hundred weight. Early planting in the Pacific Northwest has helped draw down western inventories early in the season. With PEI unable to ship seed to either the United States or Canada, other provinces have stepped up to fill those gaps in the marketplace, and all available seed will likely be utilized.
