Potatoes in Canada that are anticipated to be used for Table consumption as of May 9, 2022, are at 6.8 million hundred weight, well above both a year ago and historical levels. NB and PEI lead the stocks increases followed by Quebec and Ontario. Given the lack of very much early planting and subsequent slow growth, this will provide ample supply to allow packers to run into late summer. Stocks of table potatoes in Western Canada are quickly diminishing.
